Goliath falls into the scene w/ a big thud (David and grass jump up as he hits) - ~~blows away~~ Goliath off screen slowly

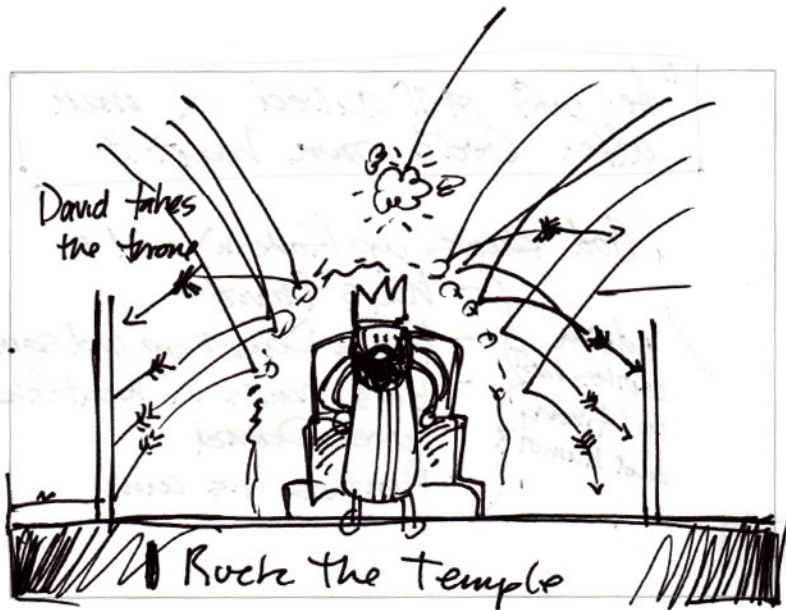
"When he was a boy David's father in God helped him kill a giant"

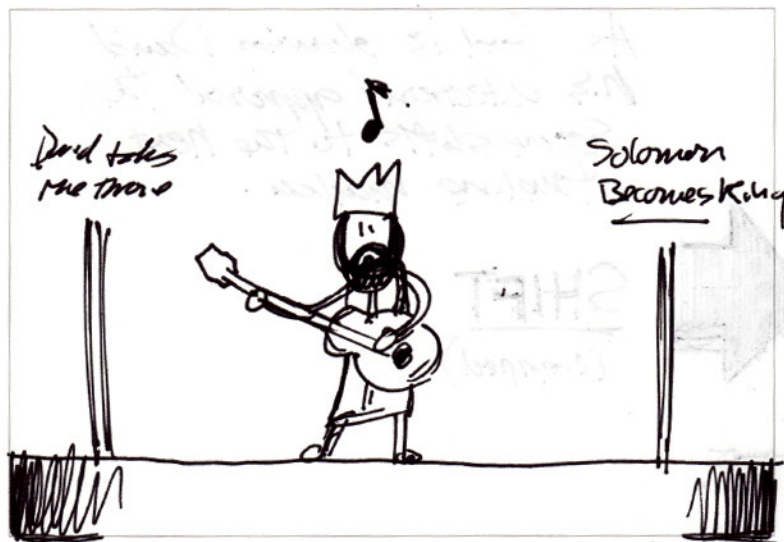

God shows up (fade in) and:

As God is showing David his affection/approval the scene shifts to the next timeline marker.

Papers (or scroll) pile up covering Solomon

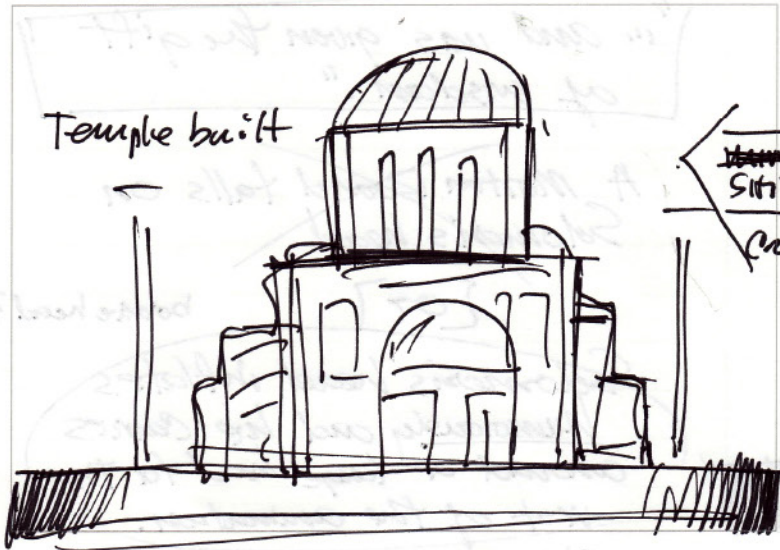
"The love story of Solomon and one of his wives is even included in scripture."

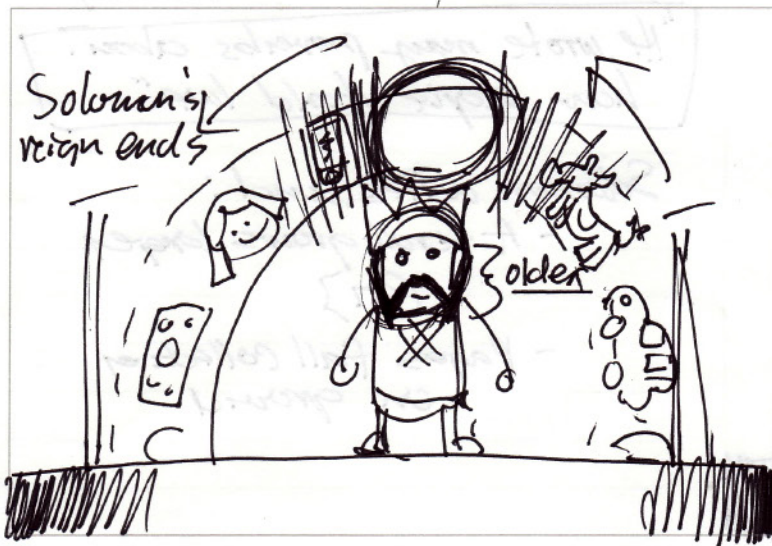

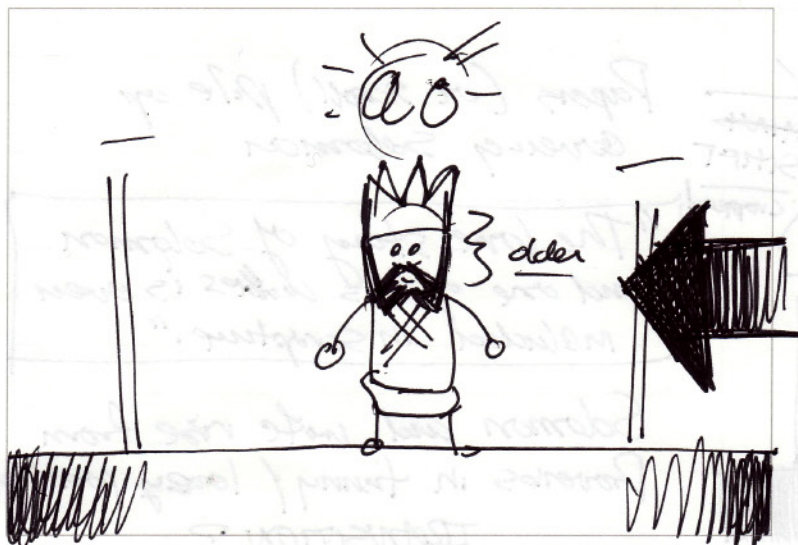

Fade game show wheel and shift to next scene



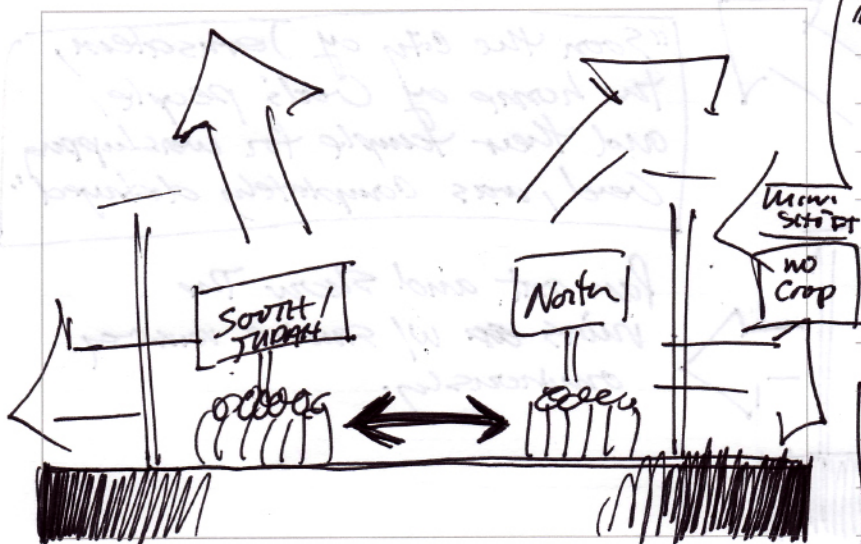

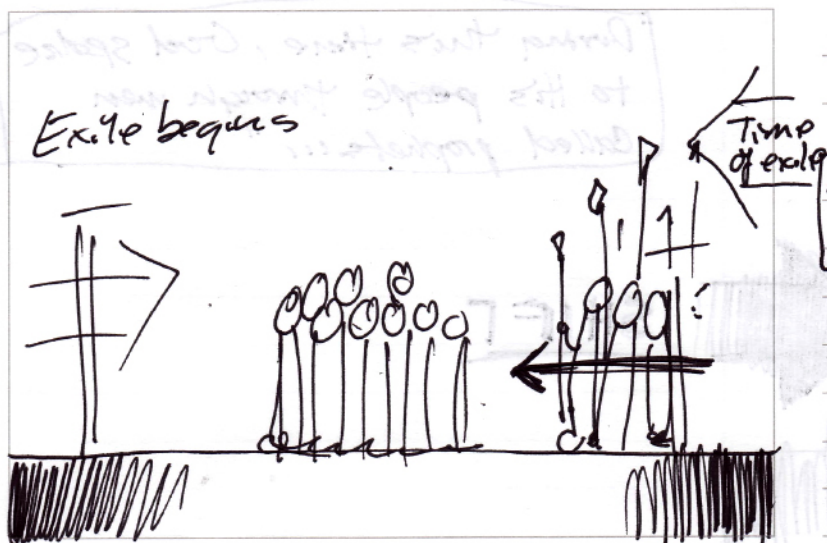
large group of people show a series of shortening exclamation point speech bubbles increasing in exclamation points, number of direction points, and bubble size.

"the Northern kingdom had some evil kings who led them into sin..."



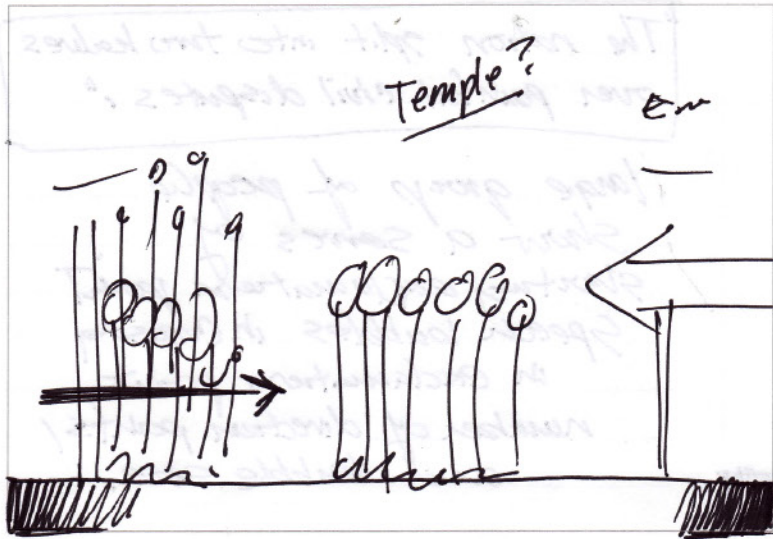
Pan over and zoom into the Right (North) group

\* Maybe attacking from the left would work better for the next pan 3



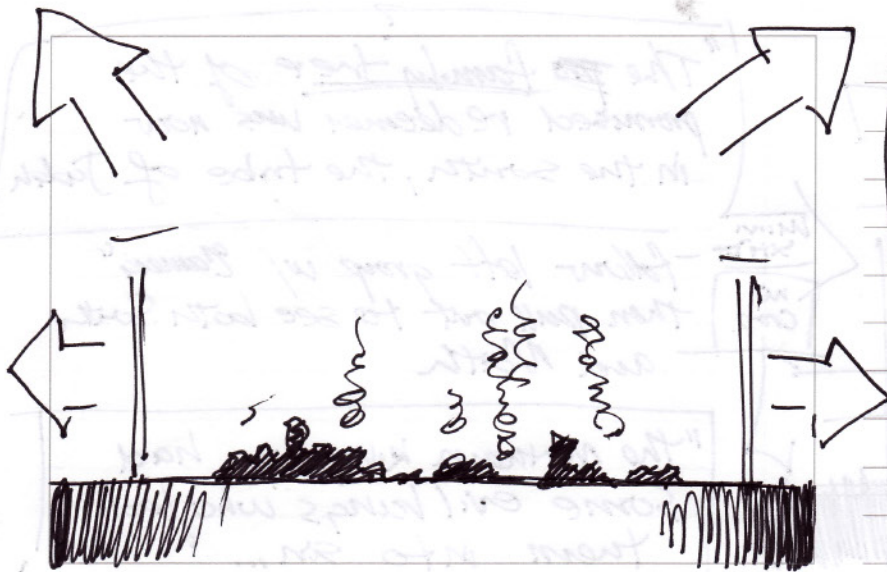

Then over to the left group

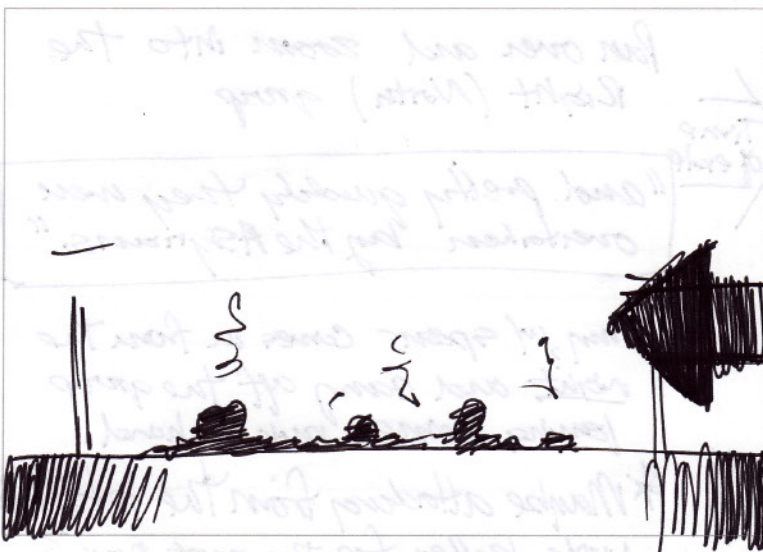

Era of two Prophets



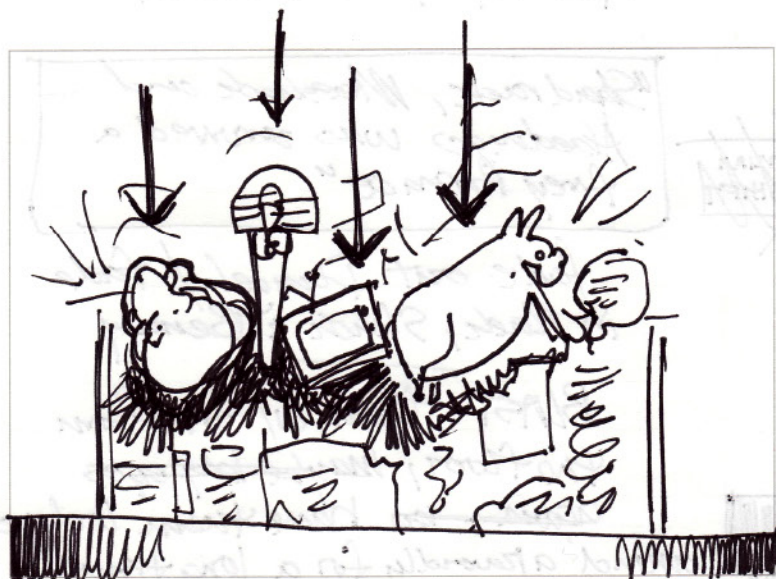

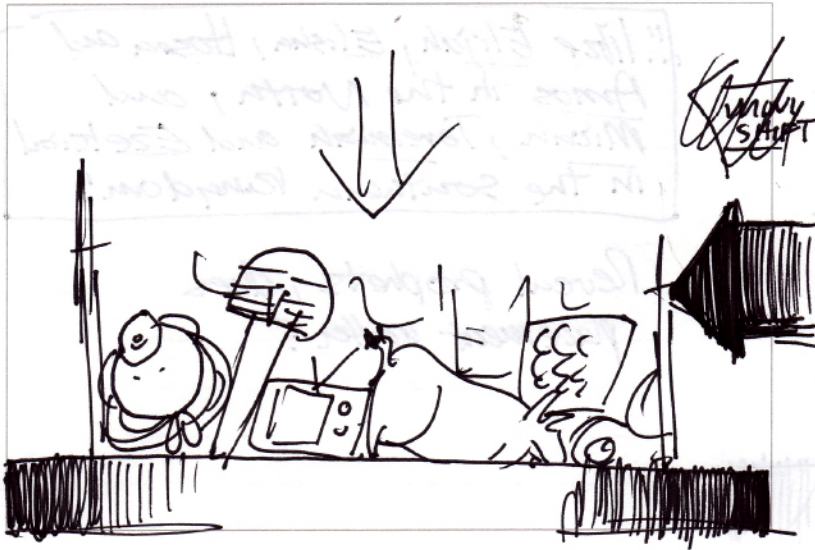

Fade in lions sleeping + put big eyes on Daniel

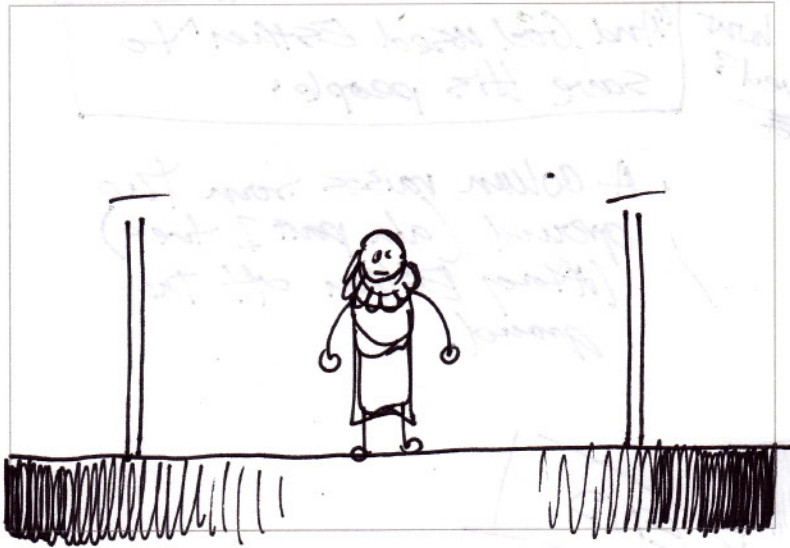


"Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego who survived a fiery furnace"

BLAST them w/ fire from the floor, ~~maybe big eyes~~ again -> have them looking around awkwardly for a long time before the BLAST for humor





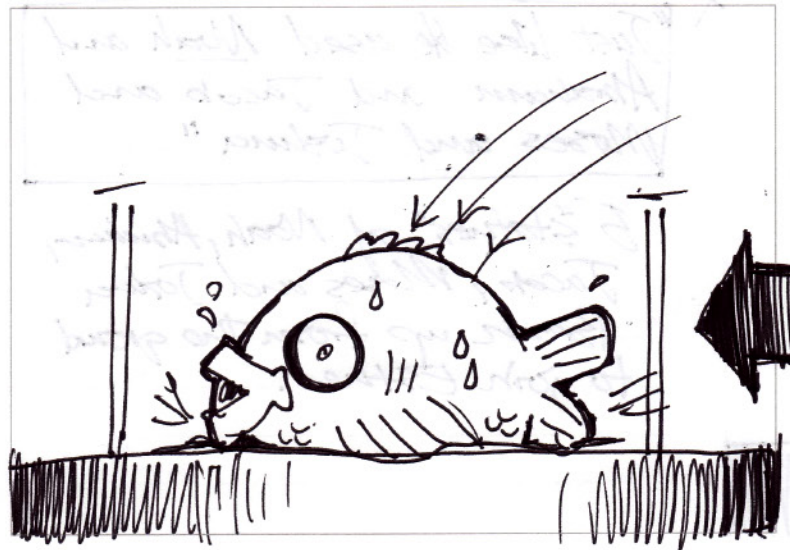

Fish swallows Jonah

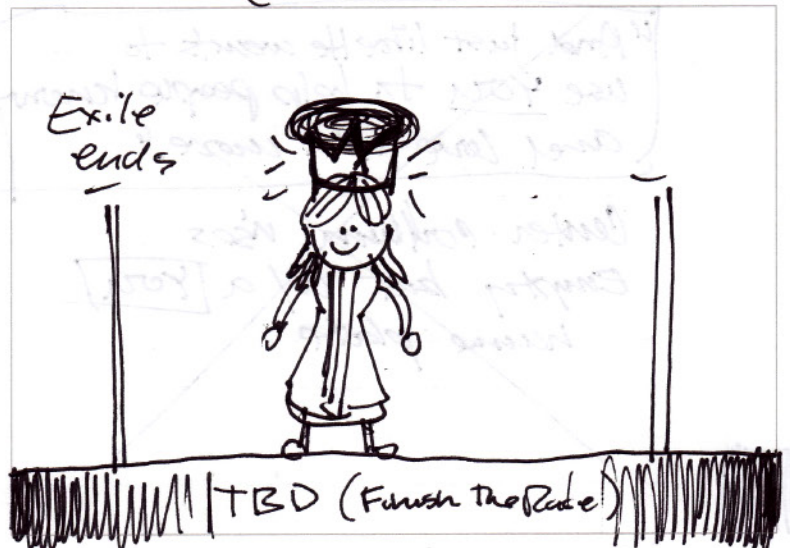
